DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show aware that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' Classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and included the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **13th March 2010**. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first place does not include a Special Prize of whatever value. A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions for this Regulation are:-

- (1) A puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed.
- (2) A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class.
- (3) As provided in Kennel Club Definitions of Classes.
- (4) A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of any emergency judge.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

Withdrawal. The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.

(2) **Transfer**

- (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

- (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty-four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class, or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class of the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (d) If an exhibit arrives late and missed a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.
- (d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

| OPEN | For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the show. |
| VETERAN | For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the show. |
| IMPORTED REGISTER | For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever. |
| A.V.N.S.C. | For breeds of dogs for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. |
| SPECIAL TEAM | For 3 exhibits of the same or different breeds representing any registered Society, all exhibits must have been entered and exhibited in other class. Dogs beaten in this class will not be considered to be beaten dogs in other competition. |
| ADULT HANDLING | For all persons aged 17 years and over – no age limit. This is a handling class and the dog will not be judged on merit |
| Young Kennel Club Handling Class | Class 6-11 years Class 12-16 years Class 17-24 years. Exhibitors may handle any dog provided it is fully registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register and eligible to be exhibited at Kennel Club licensed events. The 1 st placed exhibitor from each handling (including JHA if scheduled) class will be invited to take part in a YKC Handling Competition at Crufts 2011, provided as from the 1 st December 2010 they are fully paid up members of the YKC. For the purposes of these classes ages should be calculated as their age on the first day of the Show. Entries must be made on the entry form. You are reminded that DOGS MUST be entered in a breed class first where such a class is provided. <u>Please note</u> Handlers do not need to be YKC members to enter the handling classes, but must become a YKC member to take part in the YKC Handling competition at Crufts 2011. |

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The show will open at 9.00 a.m.
2. Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 9.30 a.m.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. **ENTRY FEES:** £3.50 First Entry per Dog. £1.00 subsequent entries for SAME DOG .Import Register and Not for Competition £1.00 per entry
7. **PRIZE MONEY** in Stakes Classes 1st £5. 2nd £3. 3rd £2. 4th £1. and A.V. Classes 1st £3. 2nd £2. 3rd £1. 4th 50p
8. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries..
9. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition
10. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. **Best Puppy in Show** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it will automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best in Group and Best in show respectively .
 - a) Show judged on the Group System
 - 1) Best Puppy in Group and Subsequent Group placings must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - 2) Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners provided they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - b) Withdrawal from Competition Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition, other than Breed classes and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety (AV) Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
 - c) Proviso For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. **Best in Show.** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same show.
 - a) Shows Judged on the Group System. (Definition shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulations B (A) and require a judge to declare a best of each group, after which the exhibit so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best In Show.)
 - 1) Best of Breed. Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be selected from which the Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award.
 - 2) Best of Group. Best of Group and subsequent placings must be selected from:-
 - a) The Best of Breed winner in each group that they are unbeaten winning dogs.
 - b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified class in each group or on each day.
 - 3) Best in Show Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
 - b) Withdrawal from other Competition. Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from AV Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
 - c) Proviso. For the purpose of this Regulation dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time. And then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

14. No modification will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press whenever possible.
15. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulations F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
16. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
17. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS-** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade-take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ALL DAMAGE CAUSED. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Rights to Refuse entries: Exhibitors/ Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.
18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered
19. The Committee of the Show can accept no responsibility for products on sale they may not meet the requirements of the regulations for the preparation of dogs for exhibition.
20. All gangways must be kept clear.
21. The use of mobile phones is not allowed within the vicinity of the rings.
22. Car Park is FREE but the Club will not be responsible for any damage caused.
23. Show entries/bank charges. Exhibitors attention is drawn to Bank Charges incurred by the society through incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques in respect of their entries, these will be passed onto the exhibitor concerned and failure to pay entry fee and bank charges (£10.00) will result in the exhibitor being reported to the Kennel Club.
