

- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade- take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

23. An exercise area will be provided at the show and exhibitors and handlers are requested to clear up any fouling made by the dogs in their charge. They are also requested to put the bags with fouling into the black bags provided. Do not leave poo bags at the door or in the car park
24. The Committee can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the show, and remind exhibitors that grooming produces on sale may not meet the requirements of Kennel Club Rules.
25. The Committee reserve the right to alter schedule order.
26. Show entries/ bank charges. Exhibitors attention is drawn to Bank Charges incurred by the society through incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques in respect of their entries these will be passed onto the exhibitor concerned and failure to pay entry fee and bank charges (£10.00) will result in the exhibitor being reported to the Kennel Club.
